We have been lucky enough to own this fabulous pub, and its sister pub The 19<sup>th</sup> Hole, for the past three years – though we have both known Elie for many years before. Rachel spent every summer of her childhood playing in the rock pools on Elie beach, and when we first met each other (many, many years ago) the first place we came to for a holiday was Elie.

There has been a pub on this site since 1832, and we are the 14<sup>th</sup> landlords of the Ship. Our aim is to look after the place during our time as custodians, and when one day we leave it to the 15<sup>th</sup> landlords, we will hopefully have left it just a little bit better than we found it.

Our vision at the Ship is hopefully a simple one - to match the world class location which nature has given us with an Inn that prides itself on friendly, professional service and great produce. And if that produce comes from the farms behind Elie, or the seas in front of you, then even better. In our time here we have enlarged the downstairs bar, created a brand-new first-floor restaurant, and added six lovely bedrooms, four of which have that stunning view across the water of which we are so proud. (We have also added lots of other stuff behind the scenes, but that is usually of less interest to our customers). And lastly we are continuing to evolve the beer garden to make best use of this wonderful spot.

In the summer it's about outside drinks, barbecues and beach cricket during the day, and lovely dinners of fabulous fresh seafood, meat, veggies and fruit by night. In the winter it's about crackling log fires, staying inside out of the cold, and maybe tapping your feet to some local live music.

And whatever the season, and whatever your age, you'll probably do it with a glass in your hand. In the summer it's rosé wine, Pimm's and crisp ales. In the winter it's luscious red wines, fabulous malt whiskies and warming local beers. Or whatever else takes your fancy. And there are always plenty of non-alcoholic options – or even our own fabulous teas. Hopefully this drinks list gives you a few ideas.

# Malt Whisky

## Highland

<b>Glendronach 12</b>	43.0%	£3.50
A dense, heavily-sherried dram, matured in a combination of the finest sherry casks, to create a warm, rich oak and sherry sweetness.		
<b>Old Pulteney 12</b>	40.0%	£3.40
Produced in the most northern distillery in Scotland, this whisky combines a flavour of sherry with sweet citrus fruit notes and even a slight hint of brine.		
<b>Glenmorangie</b>	40.0%	£3.40
This whisky fuses a honeyed sweetness with notes of citrus, vanilla and almonds, to create a delicate, but satisfying flavour.		
<b>Glengoyne 10</b>	40.0%	£3.40
Tasting of a combination of green apples, toffee and a hint of nuttiness, this is one of the only Scottish whiskies to be distilled from completely unpeated malt.		
<b>Aberfeldy 12</b>	40.0%	£3.60
A fruity, clean malt with a touch of honey and spice, to create a smooth, sweet finish.		
<b>Deanston Virgin Oak</b>	46.3%	£3.80
The sharp heady smell of lemon zest, and barley sugar, balances well with the taste of candied fruits, vanilla toffee, and heather honey.		
<b>Edradour 10</b>	40.0%	£4.00
Produced in the smallest traditional distillery in Scotland, just outside the scenic town of Pitlochry, this whisky has a creamy, light malty taste, with a delicious honey flavour.		
<b>Oban 14</b>	43.0%	£4.50
A full-blooded fruity malt with a heavenly hint of heather and a warm peaty aroma.		
<b>Clynelish 14</b>	46.0%	£5.50
A delightfully complex spicy and perfumed nose, which is followed by equally multi-layered flavours of light citrus, smooth honey, and a combination of warm spices.		
<b>Dalmore 15</b>	40.0%	£5.50
Hints of dried fruits, hazelnuts and spices give this whisky a festive Christmas smell and taste, to create a rich and warm, lingering finish.		
<b>Old Pulteney 21</b>	46.0%	£9.00
This 21 year old is a mix of Fino Sherry and refill Bourbon cask matured whisky, with a sweet start, of butterscotch and vanilla, along with hints of fruit and cinnamon.		

## Speyside

<b>Aberlour 10</b>	40.0%	£3.60
Matured in hand-selected sherry oak casks, this whisky balances the fresh, fruity aromas of early autumn apples and pears with tastes of spicy-sweet nutmeg, vanilla and honey.		
<b>Singleton 12</b>	40.0%	£4.80
Sweet and fruity on the nose with a slight woodiness and a hint of lime. A delicate & light malt.		
<b>Glenfiddich 15 Solera</b>	46.0%	£3.60
This Solera combines malts from 3 different types of casts, resulting in a whisky that is creamy & smooth with notes of pears & chocolate.		
<b>Cragganmore 12</b>	46.0%	£3.60
Fragrant with sweetish, cider notes & a smoky, peat maltiness in the finish.		
<b>Knockando 12</b>	43.0%	£3.80
The distillery of Knockando translates from Gaelic to "little black hill", and produces a whisky that is soft, light and sweet with a hint of berries.		
<b>Macallan Gold</b>	40.0%	£3.80
Lemon & orange peel with notes of vanilla & chocolate. Floral with light oak notes. boiled sweets on the palate.		
<b>Balvenie 12 Double Wood</b>	40.0%	£4.20
Aged in refill American oak casks before being finished in first fill European oak Sherry casks.		
<b>Cardhu 12</b>	40.0%	£4.00
Easy-going, charming Speysider. With clean, crisp oak and sweet malt evoking flavours of honeyed flapjacks and home-made caramel squares.		
<b>Dalwhinnie 15</b>	43.0%	£4.20
Elegant, smooth and medium-bodied, with a light, fruity palate and a whiff of heather on the finish.		
<b>Craigellachie 17</b>	46.0%	£9.00
Released for the first time in 2014. The distillery is known for its meaty character, and the 17-year-old is sweet and slightly smoky, with tropical fruit notes.		
<b>Glenfarclas 15</b>	46.0%	£4.80
Rich and sherried, aged for a little bit longer and bottled a little stronger for a more concentrated, richer flavour.		

## Island

<b>Highland Park 12</b>	40.0%	£3.20
With a delicious sweetness (heather-honey is their preferred description) and a warming, silky.		
<b>Talisker 10</b>	45.8%	£3.80
A classic Island dram from the Isle of Skye. Always highly rated, lots of spice and fresh, tangy peat.		
<b>Jura Superstition</b>	43.0%	£4.00
A union of two Jura malt whisky styles: one bold, strong and peated, the other warm and delicate.		

## Islay

<b>Smokehead</b>	43.0%	£3.20
A heavily-peated Islay single malt, hits you like a cannonball and takes you on an explosive rollercoaster of peat, smoke and spice with a little delicate sweetness thrown in.		
<b>Bowmore 12</b>	40.0%	£3.60
Lemon and honey bouquet with the distinctive Bowmore smokiness. Warm and delicious on the palate with subtle dark chocolate flavours.		
<b>Laphroaig 10</b>	40.0%	£3.80
Full-bodied, smoky gem, with a residual sweetness and a hint of salt amid the seaweedy, peaty characters before a long warming finish. A classic dram.		
<b>Bunnahabhain 12</b>	46.3%	£3.80
Lightly peated for an Islay single malt and consequently is a light, fresh dram. Now at the higher strength - for more complexity and flavour.		
<b>Ardbeg 10</b>	46.0%	£4.20
A burst of intense smoky fruit escapes into the atmosphere-peat infused with zesty lemon and lime, wrapped in waxy dark chocolate.		
<b>Bruichladdich Classic Laddie</b>	50.0%	£4.20
Unpeated and elegantly sweet with honeyed barley, boiled sweets and orange petals. Wafts of sea air.		
<b>Caol Ila 12</b>	43.0%	£4.20
Of medium weight, but still packing plenty of potent phenols, this is a refined, powerful dram with a compensating oiliness. A balanced, peaty beauty.		
<b>Kilchoman Machir Bay</b>	46.0%	£4.40
Classic smoky islay single malt on the surface however when tasted a complex balance of peat, vanilla, tropical fruit and intense sweetness combine for a truly unique Islay dram.		
<b>Lagavulin 16</b>	43.0%	£5.50
Massive peat-smoke that's typical of southern Islay - but also offering richness and a dryness that turns it into a truly interesting dram.		

## Campbeltown

<b>Springbank 10</b>	46.0%	£3.60
Wide range of aromas, from citrus fruits to pears and a hint of peat, while the palate shows touches of smoke, vanilla essence, nutmeg and cinnamon.		

## Lowland

<b>Glenkinchie 12</b>	43.0%	£3.60
Sweet, soft start that becomes flowery. It then turns crisp mid-palate, with a herbal and dry finish.		
<b>Auchentoshan Three Wood</b>	43.0%	£4.80
Matured initially in bourbon casks before being finished in Oloroso then Pedro Ximénez casks for an extra layer of rich, sweet fruitiness.

The launch of the iconic blue bottle marked gin's turning point – delicate, light and slightly sweet.			
<b>Botanist</b>	Scotland	46.0%	£4.10
Contains no fewer than 31 botanicals, of which 22 are native to the Southern Hebridean island itself.

Made with Bulgarian coriander, blueberries and blackberries as well as bittersweet Valencia orange peels. The result is well balanced and full of flavour.
